Beginning October 1, 2016 and on each October 1 thereafter, fire inspection fees shall be adjusted to reflect the cost of doing business, measured by fluctuation in the Consumer Price index (CPI) (All Urban Consumers, Miami, Fort Lauderdale, Florida) as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor, Statistics or its successor agency based on there percentage change in the CPI from the previous June to June of the year in which the adjustment is affected. The rate schedule shall be adjusted annually unless otherwise amended by an action of the City Commission. It shall not be necessary to amend this article or any part thereof by ordinance or resolution, nor to cause publication or conduct a public hearing prior to the annual adjustment of the rate schedule pursuant to this subscription. The annual adjustment for fire inspection fees as authorized above shall be kept on the file in the City Clerk's office.
