RULES OF THE RECYCLED PAINT PROGRAM

- a. Applicant must be a Miramar resident and provide 2 forms of identification for the address the recycled paint is being requested (e.g., driver license and utility bill).
- b. Each approved request can receive two (2) 5-gallon base color and one (1) 5-gallon trim color.
- c. Residents can receive paint once within a two (2) year time period.
- d. Paint is intended for exterior residential property use only and is not to be sold or used for multi-family or commercial property.

COLLECTING RECYCLED PAINT

- a. Residents will be notified by phone or email once the recycled paint is available for pick-up.
- b. Residents will be required to collect the recycled paint from the Public Works Department located at 13900 Pembroke Road during regular operating hours: Monday - Thursday 8am - 5pm.
- c. Please be sure to bring 2 forms of identification for the address the recycled paint is being requested (e.g., driver license and utility bill).
- d. Paint colors are only available while supplies last.

IMPORTANT RECYCLED PAINT INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Paint is not suitable for use with sprayers.
- b. Intended for exterior use only.
- c. Homes must be pressure washed prior to painting.
- d. Do not mix recycled paint with other paints.
- e. Paint settles naturally and will need to be stirred well prior to use.
