The intent of this project is to update the 1950's era water mains and enhance fire protection. It will also provide sanitary sewer service that will allow property owners to abandon their septic tank once connected to the new sewer system and improve storm water drainage in your neighborhood.

What's Taking Place in your Neighborhood?

Reynolds Construction plans to construct the concrete curb on Sunshine Boulevard on the west side of the road from SW 68 Terrace to the Cul-de-Sac/dead-end on Thursday, June 27, 2019 through Friday June 28, 2019.



Residents residing on the west side of Sunshine Boulevard are requested to park on the east side of Sunshine Boulevard until Friday evening to allow the curb to dry. The contractor will backfill the area between the roadway to the curb on or before Saturday morning.

For construction of curbs to proceed **NO PARKING WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE WEST SIDE OF SUNSHINE BOULEVARD BEGINNING WEDNESDAY JUNE 26, 2019 AT 4PM.**
