



HISTORIC MIRAMAR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (HMII3) Weekly Newsletter Update

The HMII3 Project Team manages the Historic Miramar Infrastructure Improvements Project, Phase 3 (HMII3). The intent of this project is to update the 1950's era water mains, construct new storm drains and swales, and enhance fire protection with additional fire hydrants. Reynolds Construction has completed all of the Historic Infrastructure Improvements in Phase 3. They are now focused on restoration of the project area.

Restoration of the HMII3 project area will include paving the final lift of asphalt on roadways throughout the project area. This work will begin on May 11, 2020 at Sunshine Boulevard to SW 68th Avenue from SW 19th Street to SW 68th Terrace and between SW 68th Avenue to SW 66th Avenue from SW 18th Street to SW 20th Street.

Shortly, the City of Miramar will announce when property owners can abandon their septic tanks and connect to the new sewer system.

The resident concerns and claims filed with Adams Consulting Group Inc. will be individually inspected by Reynolds Construction and the HMII3 team during the restoration phase of the HMII3 Project. We ask for your continued patience and understanding as Reynolds Construction and the HMII3 Team continue to address your restoration concerns.
