Reason for Proposed Action:									
 Inspection Guidelines: All applications will have an initial inspection by staff within 10 City business days from the date the application was received. Applicants will receive a determination of approval or denial via telephone or email. A second inspection will occur a minimum of 90 calendar days after the issuance of the permit to ensure compliance with the terms of the permit. Permit expires 90 calendar days after issue date. Permit extensions may be requested by the applicant in writing and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. 									

Non-refundable Application Fees:

- Residential FEE: \$54.00 for up to 2 trees noted in this application; \$81.00 from 3-6 Trees; \$6 per each additional Tree.
- Commercial FEE: \$81.00 for up to 6 Trees noted in this application; \$6 each additional Tree.

Additional Requirements:

- The submission of this application does not authorize the removal of trees. Work may not be performed until the application is approved and a permit is issued. All applicants must contact Sunshine-811 by dialing 8-1-1 to have the property marked for underground utilities that may be affected by the removal/installation of the tree(s).
- The property owner or owner's representative certifies, understands and will comply with the provisions and regulations of the City
 of Miramar Land Development Code and Code of Ordinances. All work will be done in compliance with all other applicable laws and
 regulations.
